

Fireplace Installation Checklist

Things you need to consider when installing a wood fireplace in your home.

Local Regulations

- Check your local council's wood burner regulations to see which fireplace you can use - Clean Air, Low Emission Burner (LEB), Ultra Low Emission Burner (ULEB), or Rural.

Visit a Retailer

Talk to your local fireplace specialist about:

➤ Fireplace Type

- Inbuilt or freestanding
- Heat output required
- Features i.e. cooktop or water booster
- Accessories i.e. floor protector

➤ Fireplace Location & Flue Requirements

- Decide where in the home the fireplace will go – make sure the location is clear of obstructions, including through the roof
- Identify flue requirements
- Begin consent requirements

➤ Installation & Consent Approval

- Identify your fireplace installer
- Get your fireplace installed
- Final inspection and consent approval
